Bel is actively avoiding thinking about the future but accidentally reveals her talent for engineering, where she is reluctantly forced to join the robotics club. Mateo Luna, is the captain of the robotics club who cares deeply about Nationals and building a winning machine. He recognizes Bel as an asset, but they are so different and initially just butt heads. Yet as nights of after-school work grow longer both start to realize maybe they're more than just robot building champions, and actually constructing the foundation for a budding romance.

This story provides chills and thrills that come with any sci-fi horror tale and plot twists that will leave readers deliciously dizzy.

Cristian speaks a little English and wonders about the West. Therefore, it is even more crushing when he is blackmailed and forced into spying on his fellow citizens for the Securiate after a chance encounter with a US Ambassador and his teen son. Revolution and the end of the Ceausescu government is in the air, but it will cost Cristian everything if he chooses to participate. No one is safe, no one can be trusted – not even family.
